Salina Grace exists to help meet one of our community's most urgent needs—offering a safe, welcoming place where people experiencing poverty and homelessness can turn when they have nowhere else to go.

Through the Community Resource Center and Winter Shelter, we focus on building relationships while meeting real, everyday needs. That means a warm, safe place during extreme winter weather, a dependable daytime space, and access to meals, showers, laundry, and basic supplies that help restore dignity and stability. Just as importantly, it means walking alongside people and helping connect them to employment, medical care, mental health support, housing, and other resources that open the door to lasting change. We do this work in partnership with others across the community, recognizing that no one organization can meet every need alone.

Salina Grace also serves as a central hub alongside local partners, helping people navigate services more quickly and reducing gaps in care. By working together, we can respond more effectively and make sure individuals don't fall through the cracks.

This kind of support benefits the whole community. When someone has a safe place to go in a crisis, it reduces pressure on emergency rooms and law enforcement and provides a trusted alternative to the streets. Because of generous community support, this work continues to grow—helping us not only meet immediate needs, but also build trust, stability, and real pathways forward for the people we serve.

Together, we are building a healthier, safer, and more stable community—providing not just relief in times of crisis, but real solutions that make a lasting difference.

WALKING FORWARD TOGETHER A MESSAGE FROM THE DIRECTOR

At Salina Grace, every day is a reminder that real change happens through relationships—people walking alongside people. When a neighbor comes through our doors, they're often carrying more than just immediate needs. They're navigating challenges tied to housing, health, food insecurity, employment, and hope itself. And it takes time, care, and committed support to ensure they don't slip through the cracks.

That kind of support is only possible because of you.

While we are grateful for the partnerships we have with government funding (28%) and foundations (19%), **the majority of what makes this work possible— 53%—comes directly from individuals, businesses, and churches in our community.** That means more than half of the impact happening at Salina Grace is fueled by people who simply believe in loving their neighbor and being part of the solution.

You are the reason help is accessible. You are the reason someone is greeted with dignity instead of being turned away. You are the reason a person in crisis can sit down with someone who will listen, guide, and walk with them toward stability.

This work happens through partnership. Together, we can ensure no one in our community has to navigate hardship alone.

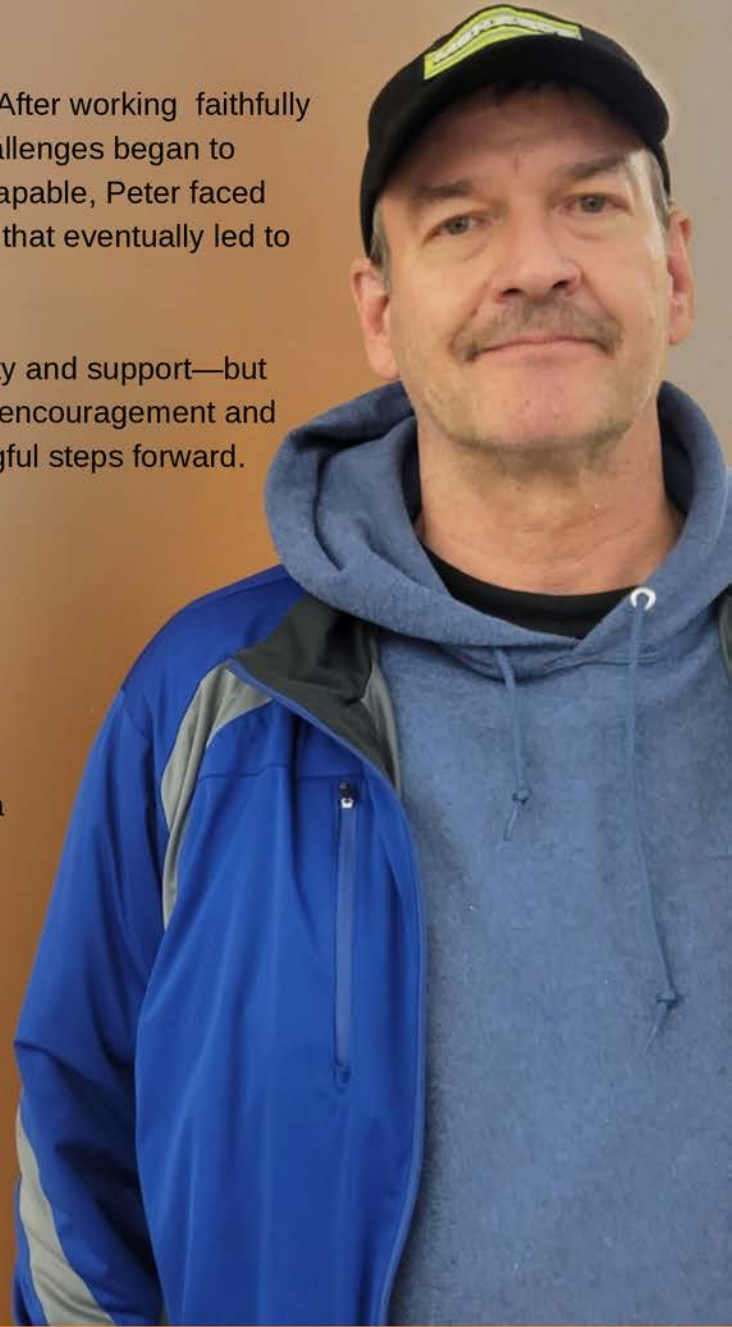
A Fresh Start: Peter's Story
